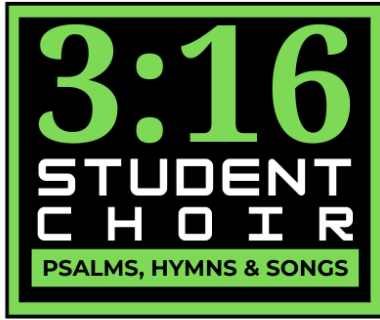

## NOTES from the Director:

We are currently working to schedule a few ministry concerts at area assisted- living homes that will be on Sunday afternoons as close to the regularly scheduled rehearsals as possible. We will update the schedule as we confirm those dates and times. These concerts consist of songs from our repertoire, hymn singing with the residents, and worship songs led by choir members.

With our limited rehearsal schedule for the Fall, we will have an open house rehearsal to allow family members to join us for a sneak peek of our rehearsals and to hear our musical progress. More ministry concerts and an END of the SEASON concert will be scheduled for the Spring. We will also schedule times when the Student Choir will sing in worship with the Porter First Worship Choir. These times are encouraged for all singers, but optional for those who have obligations at their home churches.

Monthly fellowship times following rehearsals will typically be off site. We will work with parents to arrange transportation to the homes for the events, but request that each parent pick up their student following the event. Students are encouraged to attend these fun outings, but not required.

Our students LOVE to eat. If you would like to provide a dessert or light meal for after rehearsal (nachos, hot dogs, tacos, jambalaya, etc) please contact me and we will schedule a night that works for you!

Students need to wear their choir shirts to any performances we have. **The \$25 Student Choir fee covers the cost of the shirt and helps to purchase music for the choir's 2022-2023 season.**
