

# Doors of the Bible

## 1. The Ark Door

*“Then the LORD said to Noah, “Enter the ark, you and all your household, for you alone I have seen to be righteous before Me in this time.” (Genesis 7:1)*

*“Those that entered, male and female of all flesh, entered as God had commanded him; and the LORD closed it behind him.” (Genesis 7:16)*

## 2. The Passover Door

*“Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.” (Exodus 12:7)*

*“The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.” (Exodus 12:13)*

## 3. The Temple Inner Doors

*“For the entrance of the inner sanctuary he made doors of olive wood, the lintel and five-sided doorposts. So he made two doors of olive wood, and he carved on them carvings of cherubim, palm trees, and open flowers, and overlaid them with gold; and he spread the gold on the cherubim and on the palm trees.” (1 Kings 6:31–32)*

*“For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.” (Hebrews 10:4)*



#### 4. The Sheep's Door

*“So Jesus said to them again, “Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. “All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. “I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly. “I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.” (John 10:7–11)*

#### 5. The Cross

*“He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”  
(2 Corinthians 5:21)*

*“Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.” (John 14:6)*

#### 6. The Tomb Door

*“He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said. Come, see the place where He was lying.” (Matthew 28:6)*

#### 7. The Narrow Door

*“Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. “For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.” (Matthew 7:13–14)*

**Answers:** Ark, Passover, Temple, Sheep's, Cross, Tomb, Narrow.
